

Day 1: Monday, November 4, 2024 Overnight Flight

Get ready for a true taste of southern Spain, from the sparkling blue waters of Costa del Sol to the chic avenues of Madrid. Your tour begins with an overnight flight.

Day 2: Tuesday, November 5, 2024 Málaga, Spain - Fuengirola - Tour Begins

Welcome to Málaga, one of the oldest cities in Europe, known for its sunny, Andalusian lifestyle and for being the birthplace of artist Pablo Picasso. Settle into your new surroundings and start enjoying the town of Fuengirola. Depending on your flight arrival time, join your Tour Manager and fellow travellers this evening for a welcome reception at your hotel.

Day 3: Wednesday, November 6, 2024 Fuengirola - Málaga - Fuengirola

Discover the port city of Málaga with a local guide. Walk through the colourful market stalls and learn about the history and culture of this seaside community. Let Málaga's winding old town streets and historic Roman Theatre transport you back in time, then **it's your choice!** Venture into the The Alcazaba and get to know the fortified palace with a local guide **-OR**-enter the Picasso Museum, and explore at your own pace many of the paintings by this iconic artist who called Málaga his first home. No matter which you choose, reconnect with your fellow travellers during lunch at a local's home. (*B, L, D*)

Day 4: Thursday, November 7, 2024 Fuengirola - Setenil del las Bodegas - Ronda - Fuengirola

Travel to Setenil de las Bodegas, a town known for its whitewashed houses built into the cliffs. Like many of the Andalusian white villages, Setenil has deep ties to the Arab population that once ruled the region. Enjoy some time to explore on your own before heading to Ronda. Walk the Old Town and see its 18th-century *Puente Nuevo* (New Bridge) over the El Tajo gorge. After some free time to explore on your own, head back to Fuengirola where the sunsets beckon a relaxing ending to the day. (*B*)

Day 5: Friday, November 8, 2024 Fuengirola - Marbella - Fuengirola


Journey to romantic Marbella today and enjoy a walking tour of the city's winding cobblestone streets before spending some free time to explore Marbella's charming shops, cafés, and galleries on your own. Afterwards, return to your hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure, perhaps relaxing on the beach, just a short walk from your hotel, or perhaps you'll join an optional tour to Mijas, one of Andalusia's most famous villages. (*B*, *L*)

Day 6: Saturday, November 9, 2024 Fuengirola - Granada - Fuengirola

Today travel to Granada, the last capital of the Moors in Spain before it fell to the Catholic monarchs in 1492. Here, spend the morning with a local expert visiting the Alhambra,* a UNESCO World Heritage site also known as one of the Wonders of the Muslim world. After your extensive morning walk at this centuries-old palace and fortress complex, enjoy some free time in Granada for lunch on your own before returning to your hotel in Fuengirola to spend the evening as you please. (*B*)

Day 7: Sunday, November 10, 2024 Fuengirola - Málaga - Madrid

This morning, say *adiós* to the Costa del Sol and hop on a northbound fast-speed train** to the capital city of Madrid. Relax and enjoy the scenic ride, then join a panoramic tour of the city's historic centre. See iconic sites like the Gran Via and Puerta de Alcala and get a better sense of the layout of this famous capital city. Tonight, you might choose to experience Madrid like a local with a metro ride and a walking tour followed by dinner with traditional entertainment at a local restaurant. (*B*)

Day 8: Monday, November 11, 2024 Madrid - Segovia - Madrid

This morning travel to the historic town of Segovia. Join a local guide for a walking tour and learn about its iconic Roman Aqueduct, massive 16th century cathedral, and historic Main Square. Next, take a tour of the Alcázar de Segovia (Segovia Castle), an impressive medieval castle with lavish interiors, a museum, and military archives. Enjoy lunch on your own in Segovia before heading back to Madrid. Tonight, bid farewell to Spain and your fellow travellers during dinner at a local restaurant. (*B*, *D*)

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your <u>own air</u>, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Due to local festivities, the order of your included visits may change.

Dinner times follow local custom and will be served at 7:30 p.m. or later.


Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

**A small overnight bag is required. Your main luggage will be transferred from Malaga to Madrid on the night prior of the train ride. We recommend bringing a cabin-sized duffle bag or backpack, large enough to pack your overnight belongings. You will be responsible for handling this overnight bag and any other luggage you wish to bring with you.

The overall activity level of this tour is level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveller. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. From mid-June to mid-September, temperatures can easily reach 90 degrees. The walking tour of the Alhambra will take approximately 2.5 hours; the walking tour of Segovia will take approximately 3 hours over some steep hills and uneven pavement. This level is not a fit for travellers who require mobility assistance devices.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.



Our air passengers will arrive into Malaga, Spain and transfer to Fuengirola.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

*Alhambra tickets are not guaranteed and subject to availability per Spanish Governing Authority. On the occasion that tickets are not available, you will visit another top Spanish attraction and your group leader or travel agent will be notified. Complete passport information is required 120 days prior to departure to book tickets to the Alhambra. If passport information is incomplete or inaccurate within 120 days prior to your tour departure, there is a strong possibility that we will be unable to confirm entrance tickets. You will be subject to any additional charges incurred from failing to provide passport information within the designated time frame.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more travelling on the same flights and dates.
